Topics discussed during the meeting were services available from AFS, policy updates, and speed networking of the 150th anniversary meeting, communications, diversity/equal opportunities, student chapters, effective meetings, and policy.

All attendees of the meeting were most concerned with membership, or lack there-of. Many ideas were brought to the table including: joint meetings with other chapters and units, inviting legislators to meetings, making meetings more relatable to members and students. Retaining members was also brought up. I informed the group of the member spotlight program and it was well received. Many questions were asked and discussed during this session of the meeting.

Services available

- Better diversity facilitation
 - Communications of ideas for recruitment of members of diverse backgrounds, from AFS staff to chapters
 - Strategic plan for diversity in members is in the works and will be send to unit levels from parent society
- Continuing education
 - AFS leadership is developing a course program to help students with interactions
 - Courses will instruct on interpersonal relationships, public interactions, interview skills, communications and messages, and how to make fisheries more relatable to public
 - Will be taught at the chapter and unit levels
- Publications
 - How to get more publications into AFS related periodicals
 - o More entries to allow for better selection of quality, relatable material
 - Got to AFS publications first
- Electronic Services
 - Member services survey
 - Gray literature database project
 - Website and unit website template development
 - Developing workshop for web master at next year's AFS meeting
 - No need to have good experience with new format, template is fillable so unit and chapters can have similar format
 - Possibility of webinar or webex for those who can't attend national meeting
- AFS general services updates
 - Updates brochure- "take your career farther"
 - Table top booth display
 - o Leader guide-unit leader guide

- Downloadable on AFS website
- Website security
 - Internal and external security features
 - Will be a fee to use from parent society
- Financial services
 - Meeting contracting
 - Professional meeting advisory and contracting services
 - No fee for these services
 - Chapter insurance program
 - \$2 million coverage to chapter for general liability
 - \$150 annual premium
 - Unit investment program

Policy update

- Recovery of American Wildlife Act
 - Advanced legislation to provide dedicated funding to conservation of imperiled species
 - \$1.3 billion from oil and gas revenues
- Waters of the United States-clean water act
 - Administrations trying to replace 2015 rule- all waters (including headwaters) are determined to be waters of the United States. This rule is being contested through legislators
 - o AFS is in support of 2015 rule
 - AFS developing a headwaters stream working group
- Magnuson-Stevens Act
 - AFS is working to develop policy recommendations to inform congressional efforts to reauthorize and amend federal fish legislation
 - AFs developing a special committee of marine fisheries professionals

Speed networking

- 150th anniversary meeting
 - o 2020, Columbus, OH
 - o Pre: social media blitz, merchandising, historic displays from chapters
 - o During: history, time capsule, birthday cake, railcar demonstration and history
- Communications/social media
 - o No "webmaster" required
 - AFS website template
 - Social media guidelines from AFS
 - Communications committee
- Diversity/equal opportunity
 - Travel award for undergraduate/grad students of color to attend annual meeting, \$500
 - Tool kit available from AFS to recruit diverse members, available for various levels (chapters, units, etc.)
 - o Partnering with other natural resources and non NR organizations

o Find gaps in outreach and education for diverse members

Policy

- o Utilize AFS for any national concerns that might affect chapters
- o Determine bylaws for utilizing AFS in government advocacy
- o Local issues can go directly through chapter, but consultation through AFS is suggested
