Duffy Travel Award (Mid-West Fish & Wildlife Conference Travel Award)

The Joan Duffy Memorial Travel Award honors Joan Duffy's commitment to AFS and student travel, and is a matched travel grant (up to \$200) awarded by both the Missouri Chapter and the North Central Division. The Missouri Chapter of the American Fisheries Society Student Support Trust Fund was established to assist deserving students with financial aid for their professional development in the aquatic natural resources field. Funding for the Missouri Chapter's portion of this award comes from interest earned on the Student Support Trust Fund core funds. A selection committee consisting of MOAFS members ranks applicants (with emphasis given to presenters with AFS involvement and financial need) and selects the recipient. Once selected, the award recipient is notified and presented check(s) in the amount of \$200.00 at the Mid-West Fish & Wildlife Conference. Award monies must be used for travel related expenses including lodging, registration, meals, or travel costs, for the Mid-West Fish & Wildlife Conference.

Eligibility

Applicants must be, or plan to be, enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student at a Missouri college or university during the semester when the scholarship is awarded (winter/spring semester) and pursuing a degree in the aquatics natural resource field (ex: natural resources management, fisheries science, biology, wildlife conservation, environmental science, or a related field) and traveling to the Mid-West Fish & Wildlife Conference. Applications and supporting materials must be submitted by December 1. Procedures and application are on the reverse side.

- Reference form by professional contact (e.g., instructor, supervisor, professor) that attests to the accuracy of the application. This can be submitted separately or by applicant.
